Add to the last sentence of III.3 – Route Instructions:

Cancel a lettered route instruction when you are instructed to do so or when it is not listed as active at a manned checkpoint.

Add to VI.1 - Speeds, Measurement and Timing:

Execute speed changes and observe signs/landmarks when your front wheels are even with the first part of the indicated sign or landmark except when instructed otherwise.

Change VI.4 - Speeds, Measurement and Timing:

WWV (National Bureau of Standards Institute of Standards and Technology time signal).
